## **Collections at Sonnenberg**



Sonnenberg Gardens & Mansion State Historic Park was awarded a \$25,000 matching grant from the Environmental Protection Fund's Park and Trail Partnership Grants program to create a new

collections storage area with a climate controlled environment and work area in the 145 Charlotte Street building. Conservation grade shelving and cabinetry will secure the archives, photos, maps and textiles and objects in proper storage to secure the historic fabric of our founder Mary Clark Thompson. Sonnenberg Gardens & Mansion State Historic Park will have to raise an additional \$ 2,500 in matching funds, for a total of \$27,500.
