GROUNDBREAKING!

The groundbreaking on May 21, 2021, highlighted the first milestone in the adaptive reuse of the Army Reserve Center at the southwest corner of the original Thompson Estate at Sonnenberg. The celebration was for the new entrance and driveway to be installed from Route 21 at Gibson Street. This was accomplished after successfully fundraising our first \$500k grant match which was fulfilled in 2020. This beautiful new entrance to the park will upgrade our parking with 140 spaces and provide a new admissions booth to our facility. We are currently in the quiet stages to develop the second part of this expansion which will include a maintenance facility for our tram fleet and update the existing offices while also building out a historic archives and collection area. We were awarded another EPF grant of \$500k in December 2019 for this phase and have raised all but the last \$40k to its match to date

This early summer we are asking our faithful supporters to help us with this last portion before the end of the year to secure these funds for our nonprofit. This will help us to keep our collections and archives materials from deterioration in the 1887 Historic House and best utilize the new acquisition of 145 Charlotte Street.
